

CNMCL 2012 Results Announcement Conference was held at Hong Kong Shangri-La Hotel

On March 21, 2013, CNMCL 2012 Results Announcement Conference was held on fifth floor of Hong Kong Island Shangri-La Hotel. Mr. Luo Tao, Chairman of the Board and Ms. Han Hong, CFO announced the 2012 Annual Results and communicated with investors and media. In 2012, Blister copper and copper cathode produced by the Group amounted to 175,280 tons and 22,315 tons respectively, representing increases of 16.2% and 218.7% respectively, over the same period in the previous year; and the sulfuric acid generated increased by 28.7% over 2011 to 423,494 tons. The Group recorded revenue of US\$1,532.3 million, representing an increase of 19.3% from US\$1,283.9 million in 2011. It's worth to note

that the net profit increased 62.7% to US\$168 million over last year. Also, the Group profit attributable to owners of US\$98.5 million, representing an increase of 40.7 from US\$70 million in 2011 and the basic earning per share attributable to owners of the Group was approximately US\$3.23, representing an increase of 20.1% from US\$2.69 in 2011. On March 18, the examination committee, conformity committee, remuneration committee, and nomination committee under the Board of Directors separately convened their meetings to discuss the relevant issues. On March 19, the Board of Directors discussed and passed the annual results and timely made a public announcement in accordance with the requirements of HKEx.

On March 21, CNMCL hosted its investor presentation and press conference at the Shangri-La Hotel. Then, Mr. Luo received the exclusive interviews from Tai Kung Pao and Oriental Daily.

Mr. Luo and Ms. Han had one-to-one meetings with 9 investment organizations from all over the world during that time.

By March 22, there had been 3 paper media such as

Ta Kung Pao, Oriental Daily, and Ming Pao, and 71 internet media such as Finet.hk and Finance.sina which reported the annual results of CNMCL in 2012.
